

UNDERGRADUATE EMBEDDED CERTIFICATE IN INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS

The International Business Certificate is designed to give Georgia Tech (business and non-business majors alike) undergraduate students foundational exposure to the concepts and methodologies relating to the:

- Current international business patterns and their history.
- Evolving social, political, legal and economic environments in home and host countries as they impact on international business operations and strategy,
- Major economic constructs relating to international flows/
- Financial/monetary forms and institutions that measure and facilitate international transactions, and
- Selection of optimal strategies for firms facing international opportunities and constraints.

The certificate is firmly grounded in the management and economic disciplines and supplemented by a number of carefully selected course requirements in the social science and language training. The requirements provide a solid, balanced grounding in international management on which students will be able to build in their future professional and educational endeavors.
